WHEREAS, there are only three public bus lines serving the  
south valley of Bernalillo county; and

WHEREAS, one of these routes, line 53, is the second most  
traveled route in the Bernalillo transit system; and line 10,  
also in the south valley, is the eighth most traveled route; and

WHEREAS, both of these routes are scheduled for buses to  
travel only one per hour; and

WHEREAS, the south valley is considered to be transit-  
dependent according to census data; and

WHEREAS, better public transit and improvement of  
transportation services of all kinds stimulate business and

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE  
8 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that Bernalillo county be requested to seek  
9 federal funding to support provision of mass transit services in  
10 the south valley; and

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be  
12 transmitted to the Bernalillo county commissioners and the  
13 county manager.
