A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION STUDY COMMITTEE, WITH
COOPERATION FROM THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EDUCATION AND
THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE, TO CONDUCT A STATEWIDE PUBLIC EDUCATION
STRATEGIC PLANNING PROCESS.

WHEREAS, New Mexico has been involved in multiple
restructuring and systemic change initiatives to improve the
elementary and secondary educational system; and

WHEREAS, a comprehensive framework for education that can
sustain targeted goals and objectives is necessary for long-term
support from all branches of government and the public; and

WHEREAS, the framework can be established through a
strategic planning process that provides the opportunity for all
branches of government and the public to reach consensus about
the purpose of schooling and to concentrate all efforts,

2 efficiency and effectiveness of the educational system to best
3 prepare New Mexico's students for the future;

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
5 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the legislative education study
6 committee be requested to cooperate with the state department of
7 public education and the governor's office to conduct a
8 statewide public education strategic planning process; and

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that within the planning process the
10 following elements be included:

11 A. development of a statewide strategic plan for
12 public school education that provides a well-defined vision and
13 articulated steps to achieve national preeminence in education;

14 B. consensus building among all interested and
15 designated authorities responsible for public education policy
16 to develop a common goal of improving the educational
17 opportunities and the performance of all New Mexico's children
18 and youth; and

19 C. development of a plan to coordinate the state-
20 level planning cycle with the budgeting cycle to ensure that the
21 strategic plan drives state-level funding decisions; and

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the legislative education study
23 committee findings be reported and be recommended to the first
24 session of the forty-third legislature; and

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
