REQUESTING THAT THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION MAKE
RECOMMENDATIONS ON STATEWIDE EXPULSION AND RE-ADMISSION POLICIES
TO ENCOURAGE YOUTHS TO CONTINUE THEIR EDUCATION.

WHEREAS, a small percentage of students is expelled after episodes justifying serious measures on the part of public schools; and

WHEREAS, many more students are dropped for non-attendance; and

WHEREAS, the interim legislative health and human services committee recognizes that the rise in juvenile crime and delinquency is a major problem facing New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, the interim legislative health and human services committee continues to pursue and support prevention and early

intervention measures; and

WHEREAS, each school district sets its own expulsion and re-admission policies; and

WHEREAS, such policies include provisions to respect other school districts' edicts prohibiting re-admission for up to three years; and

WHEREAS, such policies effectively close public schools to some students, putting them at high risk of gang and criminal activity; and

WHEREAS, school boards need to consider the effect their policies have on the behavior of students not permitted to attend classes; and

WHEREAS, keeping youths in an educational environment offers them important structure and role modeling necessary for becoming responsible adults;

NOW. THEREFORE. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the state board of education review and make recommendations to the interim legislative health and human services committee at its October 1996 meeting on statewide attendance, expulsion and re-admission policies; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to each member of the state board of education, the superintendent of public instruction and each local school board.
