A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE NEW MEXICO CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION TO SPONSOR LEGISLATION TO TRANSFER CERTAIN FEDERALLY OWNED PROPERTIES AT CONCHAS DAM TO PRIVATE TAXPAYERS.

WHEREAS, the United States army corps of engineers built and maintains Conchas dam; and

WHEREAS, the United States army corps of engineers has performed its traditional dam building and maintenance duties in an exemplary manner; and

WHEREAS, the United States army corps of engineers has acquired control of other property in the area that is unrelated to the maintenance of Conchas dam; and

WHEREAS, the United States army corps of engineers now owns and manages a motel, golf course and other properties that are not traditionally related to the experience or expertise of the

United States army corps of engineers; and

WHEREAS, the management of the additional properties by the United States army corps of engineers has stifled private initiative and private enterprise in the Conchas dam area; and

WHEREAS, an orderly transition of these additional properties from the control of the federal government to the private sector will promote the general welfare of the area, including Conchas and Variadero and the immediately surrounding vicinity, as well as the entire state of New Mexico, since so many New Mexicans visit the area:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico congressional delegation be requested to sponsor legislation immediately to privatize the federally owned properties in the Conchas dam area that are not directly related to the operation and maintenance of Conchas dam; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be sent to each member of the New Mexico congressional delegation.
