A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THAT THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF NEW MEXICO STATE
UNIVERSITY AND THE COMMISSION ON HIGHER EDUCATION COOPERATE IN A
STUDY OF THE FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING A VETERINARY SCHOOL AND
A LAW SCHOOL AT NEW MEXICO STATE UNIVERSITY.

WHEREAS, there is no school of veterinary medicine in New Mexico, and New Mexico residents who wish to enter that profession must leave the state to get their education; and

WHEREAS, only one law school, at the university of New Mexico, provides legal education to New Mexico residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that New Mexico state university and the commission on higher education study the feasibility of establishing a school of veterinary medicine and a school of law at New Mexico state university and that results of the study be

presented to the appropriate interim legislative committee by December 1, 1996; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the board of regents of New Mexico state university and to the commission on higher education.
