17	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:			
18	Section 1. It is proposed to amend Article 19, Section 1			
19	of the constitution of New Mexico to read:			
20	"[ <del>Any</del> ] <u>An</u> amendment or amendments to this constitution may			
21	be proposed in either house of the legislature at $[any]$ a			
22	regular session [ <del>thereof</del> ]; and if a majority of all members			
23	elected to each of the two houses voting separately [ <del>shall vote</del> ]			
24	<u>votes</u> in favor thereof [ <del>such</del> ], <u>the</u> proposed amendment or			
25	amendments shall be entered on their respective journals with

An amendment or amendments may also be proposed by an 2 independent commission established by law for that purpose, and 3 the amendment or amendments shall be submitted to the 4 legislature for approval or disapproval, provided that the 5 6 amendment or amendments may not be altered or further amended by the legislature; if approved by the legislature in accordance 7 with the provisions of this section, the amendment or amendments 8 9 proposed by the independent commission shall be submitted to the 10 electors.

The secretary of state shall [cause any such amendment or amendments to be published in at least one newspaper in every county of the state, where a newspaper is published once each week, for four consecutive weeks, in English and Spanish when newspapers in both of said languages are published in such counties, the last publication to be not more than two weeks prior to the election at which time said amendment or amendments shall be submitted to the electors of the state for their approval or rejection; and the said amendment or amendments] provide notice of the content and purpose of legislatively approved constitutional amendments in both English and Spanish to inform electors about the amendments in the time and manner provided by law. Amendments approved by the legislature shall be voted upon at the next regular election held [in said state] after the adjournment of [the] that legislature [proposing such

amendment or amendments] or at [such] <u>a</u> special election to be held not less than six months after the adjournment of [said] <u>that</u> legislature, at such time <u>and in such manner</u> as [said] <u>the</u> legislature may by law provide. [If the same be] <u>An amendment</u> <u>that is</u> ratified by a majority of the electors voting [thereon <u>such amendment or amendments</u>] <u>on the amendment</u> shall become part of this constitution.

If two or more amendments are [proposed] initiated by the legislature, they shall be so submitted as to enable the electors to vote on each of them separately. [<del>provided, that no</del> amendment shall apply to or affect the provisions of] Amendments initiated by an independent commission created by law for that purpose may be submitted by the commission separately or as a single ballot question. No amendment shall restrict the rights created by Sections One and Three of Article VII hereof, on elective franchise, and Sections Eight and Ten of Article XII hereof, on education, unless it be proposed by vote of threefourths of the members elected to each house and be ratified by a vote of the people of this state in an election at which at least three-fourths of the electors voting [in the whole state and at least two-thirds of those voting in each county in the state shall vote for such] on the amendment vote in favor of that amendment."

Section 2. It is proposed to amend Article 19, Section 2 of the constitution of New Mexico to read:

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1 "Whenever [during the first twenty-five years after the adoption of this constitution] the legislature, [by a three-2 fourths vote of the members elected to each house, or, after the 3 expiration of said period of twenty-five years] by a two-thirds 4 vote of the members elected to each house, [shall deem] deems it 5 6 necessary to call a convention to revise or amend this constitution, they shall submit the question of calling such 7 convention to the electors at the next general election, and if 8 9 a majority of all the electors voting on such questions at said 10 election in the state [shall vote] votes in favor of calling a 11 convention, the legislature shall, at the next session, provide 12 by law for calling the same. Such convention shall consist of 13 at least as many delegates as there are members of the house of 14 [The constitution adopted by such convention representatives. 15 shall have no validity until it has been submitted to and 16 ratified by the people] 17 <u>Revisions or amendments proposed by a constitutional</u> 18 convention shall be submitted to the voters of the state at an 19 election held on a date set by the convention. The revisions or

amendments proposed by the convention may be submitted in whole

or in part, or with alternatives, as determined by the

convention. If a majority vote favors a proposal or

<u>alternative, it is adopted and becomes effective thirty days</u>

<u>after the certification of the election returns unless otherwise</u> provided by the convention. "
