AN ACT
RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF
SEVERANCE TAX BONDS; AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES; MAKING
APPROPRIATIONS TO CERTAIN STATE AGENCIES AND STATE FUNDS FOR
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS, PLANNING AND RELATED PURPOSES;
REAUTHORIZING AND APPROPRIATING BALANCES OF CERTAIN SEVERANCE
TAX BOND PROCEEDS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS-- AUTHORIZATIONS--
APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS.--

A. The state board of finance may issue and sell
severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding
Act in an amount not to exceed the total of the amounts
authorized for purposes specified in Sections 2 through 19 of

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1 this act. The state board of finance shall schedule the
2 issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and
3 economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the
4 project has developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and
5 that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable
6 time. The state board of finance shall further take the
7 appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue
8 Code of 1986, as amended. Proceeds from the sale of the bonds
9 are appropriated for the purposes specified in Sections 2
10 through 19 of this act.

11 B. The agencies named in Sections 2 through 19 of
12 this act shall certify to the state board of finance when the
13 money from the proceeds of the severance tax bonds authorized in
14 this section is needed for the purposes specified in the
15 applicable sections of this act.

16 C. If the specified agency has not certified the
17 need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year
18 1998, the authorization provided in this act shall be void.

19 D. Unless otherwise specified in this act, any
20 unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining from the proceeds
21 from severance tax bonds issued pursuant to Sections 2 through
22 19 of this act after fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the
23 severance tax bonding fund.

24 Section 2. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--STATE AGENCY ON AGING--
25 PURPOSES.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act,

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1 upon certification by the state agency on aging that the need
2 exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are
3 appropriated to the state agency on aging for the following
4 purposes:

5 A. thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) for the purpose
6 of purchasing recreation equipment for the Pajarito senior
7 center in Albuquerque located in Bernalillo county;

8 B. thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) for the purpose
9 of purchasing recreation equipment for the Rio Bravo senior
10 center in Albuquerque located in Bernalillo county;

11 C. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the
12 purpose of completing the expansion of the daycare area at
13 Barelas senior center daycare in Albuquerque located in
14 Bernalillo county;

15 D. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) for the
16 purpose of planning, designing, constructing, expanding or
17 equipping a life-cycle kitchen and recreation room and therapy
18 pool at the Casa de Buena Salud senior center located in Curry
19 county;

20 E. one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars
21 (\$175,000) for the purpose of designing, constructing or
22 equipping an adult daycare facility at the north valley senior
23 citizen center located in Bernalillo county;

24 F. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the purpose
25 of completing the senior center, including finishing the

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1 interior and equipping the kitchen, located in or near Bread
2 Springs chapter located in McKinley county;

3 G. eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000) for the purpose
4 of planning or designing two pueblo of Laguna senior centers in
5 Cibola county;

6 H. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) for the
7 purpose of constructing a senior center at Santo Domingo pueblo
8 in Sandoval county.

9 I. ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the purpose of
10 acquiring recreational equipment for senior citizens at the East
11 Side community center in Las Cruces located in Dona Ana county;

12 J. thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) for the
13 purpose of equipping and furnishing a children's daycare
14 facility, an adult daycare facility and a multipurpose classroom
15 at the Los Volcanes senior center located in Bernalillo county;

16 K. one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for
17 the purpose of designing, constructing or equipping a new
18 permanent meal site building north of San Antonio for senior
19 citizens in the northeast heights section of Albuquerque located
20 in Bernalillo county;

21 L. one hundred thirty-one thousand dollars
22 (\$131,000) to purchase and install a modular building for the
23 Rock Springs senior citizen center in McKinley county;

24 M. one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to
25 plan and design a south side senior citizen center in the city

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1 of Santa Fe located in Santa Fe county;

2 N. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the purpose
3 of completing construction, including archaeological site
4 mitigation, of a senior citizen center at San Miguel del Vado
5 located in San Miguel county;

6 O. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for planning,
7 designing or constructing a senior citizen center at Santo
8 Domingo pueblo located in Sandoval county;

9 P. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for
10 landscaping and parking lot improvements for the senior citizen
11 center in Portales in Roosevelt county;

12 Q. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to design,
13 construct, equip or furnish the Des Moines senior citizen center
14 and purchase a new vehicle for the center in Union county;

15 R. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to design,
16 construct or equip the Angel Fire senior citizen center in
17 Colfax county;

18 S. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to design,
19 construct, equip or furnish the Cimarron senior citizen center
20 and recreational facility in Colfax county;

21 T. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for
22 construction of a senior citizen center in the pueblo of Zuni
23 located in McKinley county;

24 U. forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) for the purpose
25 of planning and designing a senior citizen center to be used

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1 also as a multipurpose building at Iyanbito chapter located in
2 McKinley county;

3 V. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) for the
4 purpose of designing, constructing and equipping a community
5 senior citizen center for the Newcomb Navajo chapter located in
6 San Juan county; and

7 W. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the purpose
8 of designing, constructing or equipping the Torreon senior
9 center for the Torreon and Starlake Navajo chapter located in
10 Sandoval county.

11 Section 3. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--OFFICE OF CULTURAL
12 AFFAIRS--PURPOSES.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of
13 this act, upon certification by the office of cultural affairs
14 that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, the
15 following amounts are appropriated to the office of cultural
16 affairs for the following purposes:

17 A. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the
18 purpose of constructing El Camino Real state monument for the
19 museum of New Mexico located in Socorro county. The
20 certification and issuance of the bonds is contingent upon
21 receipt of funds from federal sources;

22 B. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the purpose
23 of planning or designing a cultural museum in the city of Santa
24 Fe located in Santa Fe county; and

25 C. one hundred forty thousand dollars (\$140,000) for

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1 the purpose of making renovations addressing accessibility
2 concerns at the New Mexico museum of natural history and science
3 in Albuquerque located in Bernalillo county.

4 Section 4. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--COMMISSION ON HIGHER
5 EDUCATION--PURPOSE. --Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of
6 this act, upon certification by the commission on higher
7 education that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds,
8 one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) is appropriated to the
9 commission on higher education for the purpose of planning,
10 designing or constructing a Navajo community college in Shiprock
11 located in San Juan county.

12 Section 5. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
13 ADMINISTRATION--PURPOSES. --Pursuant to the provisions of Section
14 1 of this act, upon certification by the local government
15 division of the department of finance and administration that
16 the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following
17 amounts are appropriated to the local government division of the
18 department of finance and administration for the following
19 purposes:

20 A. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the purpose
21 of repairing, renovating or making improvements to the Colfax
22 county courthouse in Raton located in Colfax county;

23 B. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the
24 purpose of constructing a fire station-community center facility
25 at Chamita located in Rio Arriba county;

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1 C. one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars
2 (\$125,000) for the purpose of land purchase and planning,
3 designing or constructing basketball courts in the village of
4 Bosque Farms located in Valencia county. The certification and
5 issuance of the bonds is contingent upon matching funds received
6 for the project from the village of Bosque Farms;

7 D. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the purpose
8 of land acquisition and to plan, design, construct, equip or
9 furnish the Corrales recreation center located in Sandoval
10 county;

11 E. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the
12 purpose of continuing construction on a recreational park and
13 educational camp located in Dona Ana county;

14 F. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the purpose
15 of equipping or furnishing the Chaparral community center
16 located in Dona Ana county;

17 G. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the purpose
18 of improving or updating equipment for the Moriarty fire
19 department serving residents of Estancia located in Torrance
20 county;

21 H. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the
22 purpose of remodeling or renovating the Court junior high youth
