A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE NEW MEXICO CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION TO SEEK FEDERAL FUNDS FOR THE SHIPROCK MULTIPURPOSE CENTER IN SAN JUAN COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the Shiprock community in San Juan county has pursued with substantial energy and commitment the need for construction of a multipurpose center to serve critical needs of the Shiprock community, including in particular the very young and very old; and

WHEREAS, the state of New Mexico has recognized the important needs of the Shiprock community and appropriated five hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$560,000) for planning, design, construction and equipment for the Shiprock multipurpose center; and

WHEREAS, the Navajo nation has similarly recognized the important needs of the Shiprock community and committed two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for planning, design, construction and equipment for the Shiprock multipurpose center;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the federal government be requested to pursue funding options that might be available to contribute ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) to help complete construction of the Shiprock multipurpose center; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the New Mexico congressional delegation be urged to contact all appropriate federal officials to pursue funding options that might be available from the federal government to contribute ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) to the construction of the Shiprock multipurpose center; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be sent to all members of the New Mexico congressional delegation.
