RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYEE SALARIES; INCREASING CERTAIN PUBLIC Employee salary levels; making appropriations.
be It enacted by the legislature of the state of new mexico:
Section 1. APPROPRIATIONS--GENERAL FUND...
A. Fifty-two million four hundred ninety-two thousand five hundred dollars (\$52,492,500) is appropriated from the general fund to the department of finance and administration for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for the purpose of providing salary increases to certain public employees as follows:
(1) thirty-two million one hundred sixty-three thousand six hundred dollars $(\$ 32,163,600)$ to be distributed to the state equalization guarantee distribution of the public school fund to provide an average three percent salary increase for all employees in the public school system, including
certified and noncertified personnel and transportation employees;
(2) twelve million nine hundred twenty-four thousand three hundred dollars $(\$ 12,924,300)$ to be distributed to the commission on higher education to provide an average three percent increase in the salaries of all state employees in post-secondary educational institutions and in vocational schools under their respective jurisdictions;
(3) five million three hundred fifty-nine thousand five hundred dollars $(\$ 5,359,500)$ to be distributed to state agencies in the executive branch of state government whose funds are derived substantially from the general fund to provide salary increases or adjustments to state employees as follows:
(a) four million six hundred twenty-four thousand dollars $(\$ 4,624,000)$ to provide classified employees in agencies governed by the Personnel Act with the following: 1) for those employees whose salaries are equal to or above the maximum of their salary range, a lump-sum payment equivalent to three percent of the midpoint value of their salary range, subject to satisfactory job performance and payable in the first full pay period after the anniversary date of their appoint ment to their current class; and 2) for other classified employees, a salary increase equivalent to three percent of the midpoint value of the employee's salary range, subject to satisfactory job performance and effective in the first full pay period after .113944 .1
the employee's anniversary date; and
(b) seven hundred thirty-five thousand
five hundred dollars (\$735,500) to provide exempt employees with the following: 1) for those employees whose salaries are equal to or above the maximum of their salary range, a lump-sum payment equivalent to three percent of the midpoint value of their salary range, subject to satisfactory job performance and payable in the first full pay period after the anniversary date of their appoint ment to their current class; and 2) for other exempt employees, a salary increase equivalent to three percent of the midpoint value of the employee's salary range, subject to satisfactory job performance and effective in the first full pay period after the employee's anniversary date;
(4) three hundred twenty-two thousand eight hundred dollars $(\$ 322,800)$ to provide commissioned officers of the New Mexico state police division of the department of public safety with a salary increase equivalent to three percent of the midpoint value of the employee's salary range, subject to satisfactory job performance and effective in the first full pay period after the employee's anniversary date;
(5) nine hundred ninety-three thousand dollars (\$993, 000) to be distributed to the administrative office of the courts to provide salary increases and adjustments for judicial employees in accordance with the judicial personnel and compensation plan and salary increases for justices and judges;
(6) five hundred seventy-six thousand three hundred dollars $(\$ 576,300)$ to be distributed to the administrative office of the district attorneys to provide salary increases and adjustments in accordance with the district attorneys employee pay plan and salary increases for district attorneys; and
(7) one hundred fifty-three thousand dollars (\$153,000) to be distributed to the Iegislative council service, I egislative finance committee and legislative education study committee to provide an average three percent increase in the salaries of all legislative employees, subject to satisfactory job performance and effective in the first full pay period after the employee's anniversary date.
B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balances remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. APPROPRIATIONS--OTHER STATE FUNDS.-For those state agencies whose funds are substantially derived from state funds other than the general fund, the department of finance and administration shall transfer from the appropriate fund to the appropriate agency the amount required for salary increases equivalent to those provided for in Section 1 of this act, and such amounts are appropriated for expenditure in fiscal year 1998. Any unexpended or unencumbered balances remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the appropriate fund.
