The state board 2 of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to 3 comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The 4 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the New 5 6 Mexico office of Indian affairs for the purpose of planning and designing a heritage center at San Juan pueblo located in Rio 7 Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining 8 Arriba county. 9 at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax 10 bonding fund. If the New Mexico office of Indian affairs has 11 not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end 12 of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this section 13 shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
