1 upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can 2 proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board 3 of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to 4 comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. 5 The 6 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the local government division of the department of finance and 7 administration for the purpose of planning, design, remodeling 8 9 and renovations of the Court youth center in Las Cruces located 10 in Dona Ana county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance 11 remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the 12 severance tax bonding fund. If the local government division of 13 the department of finance and administration has not certified 14 the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 15 1999, the authorization provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.

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
