AN ACT

MAKING A SPECIAL APPROPRIATION FOR SUPPORT OF CERTAIN
INFORMATION-GATHERING AND EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS ON MULTIPLE-
CHEMICAL SENSITIVITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. One hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$160,000) is appropriated from the general fund for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 to the following agencies for the following purposes:

(1) one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) to the division of epidemiology, evaluation and planning of the department of health to conduct a study on the prevalence, economic impact and related factors of the condition of multiple-chemical sensitivity; and

(2) thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) to

7 at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
