The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for the purpose of acquiring and installing video cameras for police vehicles in the city of Las Vegas located in San Miguel county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the local government division of the department of finance and administration has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this section shall be void.
