19	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
20	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
21	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
22	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding three million dollars
23	(\$3,000,000) when the board of regents of the university of New

the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the board of regents of the university of New Mexico for the purpose 8 of designing, planning, constructing and equipping the phase three continuation of the expansion and renovation of the university of New Mexico football stadium located in Bernalillo 12 county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at 13 the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax 14 If the board of regents of the university of New bonding fund. Mexico has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
