18	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
19	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
20	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
21	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding thirty thousand
22	dollars (\$30,000) when the state department of public education
23	certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. The state
24	board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the
25	bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible

1 upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can 2 proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board 3 of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to 4 comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. 5 The 6 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the state department of public education for the purpose of 7 purchasing and installing computer hardware and for installing 8 9 an electrical system for computers at Valle Vista elementary 10 school located in Bernalillo county. Any unexpended or 11 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 12 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the state 13 department of public education has not certified the need for 14 the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the 15 authorization provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
