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AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO TRAIN OR HIRE EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS FOR THE JEMEZ VALLEY IN SANDOVAL COUNTY; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the department of health for expenditure in fiscal years 1997 and 1998 for the purpose of hiring, and training if necessary, two additional licensed emergency medical technicians to be stationed at the pueblo of Jemez and to respond to emergency medical needs of Jemez valley residents. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public

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peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
