AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO ENABLE THE CITY OF LAS CRUCES TO STUDY THE LOWER RIO GRANDE VALLEY WATER BASIN; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for expenditure in fiscal years 1997 and 1998 to enable the city of Las Cruces to conduct a study of the lower Rio Grande valley water basin. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
