AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; CHANGING THE PURPOSE OF A  
SEVERANCE TAX BOND APPROPRIATION; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION;  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--NEW MEXICO OFFICE OF  
INDIAN AFFAIRS--CHANGE IN PURPOSE-- APPROPRIATION. --The balance  
of severance tax bonds appropriated to the New Mexico office of  
Indian affairs pursuant to Subsection B of Section 9 of Chapter  
4 of Laws 1996 (1st S.S.) for the purpose of planning, designing  
or constructing a group home for disabled senior citizens at  
Tohatchi located in McKinley county shall not be expended for  
its original purpose but is reauthorized and appropriated to the  
New Mexico office of Indian affairs for the purpose of planning,  
designing or constructing a group home for disabled citizens at

2 Section 2. EMERGENCY. --It is necessary for the public
