AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; CHANGING THE PURPOSE OF A SEVERANCE TAX BOND APPROPRIATION; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--NEW MEXICO OFFICE OF Section 1.
