17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding five hundred thousand
21	dollars (\$500,000) when the state highway and transportation
22	department certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds.
23	The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale
24	of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner
25	possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been

1 developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. 2 The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps 3 necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as 4 The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are 5 amended. 6 appropriated to the state highway and transportation department for the purpose of street improvements, including pavements, 7 construction of a signalized school zone and extending curbs and 8 9 gutters, in the city of Lordsburg located in Hidalgo county. 10 Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of 11 fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. 12 If the state highway and transportation department has not 13 certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of 14 fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this section 15 shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
