AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIMINAL LAW; AMENDING A SECTION OF THE NMSA 1978 TO EXPAND THE DEFINITION OF THE CRIME OF SHOOTING AT OR FROM A MOTOR VEHICLE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 30-3-8 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1987, Chapter 213, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

"30-3-8. SHOOTING AT DWELLING OR OCCUPIED BUILDING--SHOOTING AT OR FROM A MOTOR VEHICLE.--

A. Shooting at a dwelling or occupied building consists of willfully discharging a firearm at a dwelling or occupied building. Whoever commits shooting at a dwelling or occupied building that does not result in great bodily harm to another person is guilty of a fourth degree felony. Whoever commits shooting at a dwelling or occupied building that results

in injury to another person is guilty of a third degree felony. Whoever commits shooting at a dwelling or occupied building that results in great bodily harm to another person is guilty of a second degree felony.

- В. Shooting at or from a motor vehicle consists of willfully discharging a firearm at or from a motor vehicle [with reckless disregard for the person of another].
- C. Whoever commits shooting at or from a motor vehicle that does not result in injury or great bodily harm to another person is guilty of a fourth degree felony.
- Whoever commits shooting at or from a motor vehicle, with reckless disregard for the person of another, that results in injury to another person is guilty of a third degree fel ony.
- Whoever commits shooting at or from a motor vehicle, with reckless disregard for the person of another, that results in great bodily harm to another person is guilty of a second degree felony.
- [C.] F. This section shall not apply to a law enforcement officer discharging a firearm in the lawful performance of his duties."
