AN ACT

RELATING TO CHILDREN; EXPANDING THE DEFINITION OF A FAMILY IN NEED OF SERVICES; AMENDING A SECTION OF THE CHILDREN'S CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 32A-3A-2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993, Chapter 77, Section 64) is amended to read:

"32A-3A-2. DEFINITIONS.--As used in the Family in Need of Services Act:

- A. "family in need of services" means:
- (1) a family whose child, subject to compulsory school attendance, is absent from school without authorized excuse more than ten days during a school semester;
- (2) a family whose child is absent from the child's place of residence for twenty-four hours or more without the consent of the parent, guardian or custodian;

1	(3) a family in which the parent, guardian or
2	custodian of a child refuses to permit the child to live with
3	the parent, guardian or custodian; [or]
4	(4) a family in which the child refuses to live
5	with his parent, guardian or custodian; or
6	(5) a family with a child who has been
7	emotionally, physically or sexually abused or neglected;
8	B. "family needs assessment" means an evaluation of
9	a child and family for the purpose of identifying the family's
10	specific strengths as well as the problems and needs of the
11	child and family;
12	C. "family services" means services that address
13	specific needs of the family and include:
14	(1) family preservation services;
15	(2) child care services;
16	(3) homemaker services;
17	(4) crisis counseling;
18	(5) transportation services;
19	(6) community mental health services;
20	(7) individual, family or group counseling
21	servi ces;
22	(8) parent training services;
23	(9) recreational services; and
24	(10) community-based services; <u>and</u>
25	D. "plan for family services" or "plan" means an

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intervention plan based on the needs of the child and family that incorporates the family's strengths and is developed as part of the assessment and referral process."

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
