20	A. A school district election shall be held in each
21	school district to elect qualified persons to membership on a
22	local school board. No person shall become a candidate for
23	membership on a board unless his record of voter registration
24	shows that he is a qualified elector of the state, [and a

which he is a candidate <u>and physically resided in the district</u>					
on the date of the school board's proclamation calling a regular

B. A regular school district election shall be held					
in each school district on the first Tuesday in February of each					
odd-numbered year.					
C. A school district election held at any time other					
than the date for the regular school district election shall be					
a special school district election.					
D. Except as otherwise provided in the School					
Election Law, school district elections shall be called,					
conducted and canvassed as provided in the Election Code."
