PUBLIC REGULATION COMMITTEE CREATED TERMINATIONThere is created a joint interim legislative committee which shall be known as the "public regulation committee". The committee shall function from the date of its appointment until the first day of December prior to the second session of the forty-third legislature. Section 2. MEMBERSHIPAPPOINTMENTVACANCIES A. The public regulation committee shall be composed of eight members. The New Mexico legislative council shall appoint four members from the house of representatives and four
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the legislative council shall designate the chairman and vice
 chairman of the committee.

Members shall be appointed from each house so as **B**. 3 to give the two major political parties in each house the same 4 proportionate representation on the committee as prevails in 5 each house; however, in no event shall either party have less 6 than one member from each house on the committee. At the 7 request of the committee chairman, members may be removed from 8 the committee by the New Mexico legislative council for 9 nonattendance according to council policy. Vacancies on the 10 committee, however caused, may be filled by the legislative 11 council, or the council may reduce the size of the committee by 12 not making replacement appointments and in such case need not 13 readjust party representation. 14

C. No action shall be taken by the committee if a majority of the total membership from either house on the committee rejects such action.

Section 3. DUTIES.--After its appointment, the public regulation committee shall hold one organizational meeting to develop a work plan and budget for the ensuing interim. The work plan and budget shall be submitted to the New Mexico legislative council for approval. Upon approval of the work plan and budget by the legislative council, the committee shall examine the statutes, constitutional provisions, regulations and court decisions governing the public utility commission and the

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state corporation commission in New Mexico and recommend legislation or changes if any are found to be necessary to the second session of the forty-third legislature.

Section 4. SUBCOMMITTEES.--Subcommittees shall be created only by majority vote of all members appointed to the public regulation committee and with the prior approval of the New Mexico legislative council. A subcommittee shall be composed of at least one member from the senate and one member from the house of representatives, and at least one member of the minority party shall be a member of the subcommittee. All meetings and expenditures of a subcommittee shall be approved by the full committee in advance of such meeting or expenditure, and the approval shall be shown in the minutes of the committee.

Section 5. REPORT.--The public regulation committee shall make a report of its findings and recommendations for the consideration of the second session of the forty-third legislature. The report and suggested legislation shall be made available to the New Mexico legislative council on or before December 15 preceding that session.

Section 6. STAFF.--The staff for the public regulation committee shall be provided by the legislative council service.

Section 7. APPROPRIATION. -- Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the legislative council service for expenditure in fiscal years 1997 and 1998 for the purpose of paying the salaries and expenses of

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1 the technical, legal, clerical and stenographic assistants, for necessary equipment and supplies used in carrying out the 2 provisions of this act and for reimbursing the per diem and 3 mileage expenses of the public regulation committee. Any 4 unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of 5 fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
