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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSAUTHORIZATIONS
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS
19	A. The state board of finance may issue and sell
20	severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding
21	Act in an amount not to exceed the total of the amounts
22	authorized for purposes specified in Subsections E through G of
23	this section for capital improvements in the village of Los
24	Ranchos de Albuquerque in Bernalillo county. The state board of
25	finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the

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most expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. Proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated for the purposes specified in Subsections E through G of this sections.

B. The agencies named in Subsections E through G of this section shall certify to the state board of finance when the money from the proceeds of the severance tax bonds authorized in this section is needed for the purposes specified in the applicable subsections.

C. If the specified agency has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this act shall be void.

D. Unless otherwise specified in this act, any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining from the proceeds of severance tax bonds issued pursuant to this act at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund.

E. Upon certification of the department of environment, forty-three thousand dollars (\$43,000) is appropriated to the department for water system improvements in the village of Los Ranchos de Albuquerque.

F. Upon certification of the local government

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1	division of the department of finance and administration, forty-
2	nine thousand dollars (\$49,000) is appropriated to the division
3	for park improvements in the village of Los Ranchos de
4	Al buquerque.
5	G. Upon certification of the state highway and
6	transportation department, the following amounts for the
7	following purposes are appropriated to the department for
8	projects in the village of Los Ranchos de Albuquerque:
9	(1) sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) for road
10	maintenance; and
11	(2) fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for a road
12	improvements study.
13	Section 2. EMERGENCYIt is necessary for the public
14	peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
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
