MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE WESTERN GOVERNORS' VIRTUAL UNIVERSITY INITIATIVE; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the department of finance and administration for expenditure in fiscal years 1997 and 1998 for the purpose of funding New Mexico's participation in the western governors' virtual university initiative. As part of New Mexico's extended learning initiative, which is designed to stimulate interest in and coordinate the delivery of high-quality, competency-based electronically delivered learning opportunities that are recognized and valued by students, employers and institutions of higher education, the commission on higher education shall
