1 board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to 2 contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance 3 shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply 4 with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. 5 The 6 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the board of regents of New Mexico highlands university for the 7 purpose of acquiring the necessary land and to renovate and 8 9 expand the Douglas school on the campus of New Mexico highlands 10 university located in San Miguel county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 11 12 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the board of 13 regents of New Mexico highlands university has not certified the 14 need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 15 1999, the authorization provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
