18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
19	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
20	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
21	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
22	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding seventeen million
23	three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$17,350,000) when the
24	board of regents of New Mexico state university certifies the
25	need for the issuance of the bonds. The state board of finance

shall schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986. as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the board of regents of New Mexico state university for the purpose of designing, constructing and equipping a building to house classrooms, scientific laboratories and administrative and faculty offices on the main campus at New Mexico state university located in Dona Ana county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the board of regents of New Mexico state university has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
