BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. PUBLIC EMPLOYEES--PARENTAL LEAVE.--Each employer shall permit all permanent employees to take up to eight hours of noncumulative leave, without loss of pay, during each school year for each of the employee's children for the purpose of attending non-athletic activities of the school in which that child participates and that are conducted during the employee's hours of work. This leave shall be in addition to any other holiday or annual leave provided for by law or rule. For purposes of this section, "employer" means every state agency or board responsible for personnel policy, and includes the executive, legislative and judicial branches of government,
