be It enacted by the legi Slature of the state of new mexico:
Section 1. A new section of Chapter 59 A , Article 16 NMSA 1978 is enacted to read:
"[ NEW MATERIAL] DISCRIMINATION AGAINST PERSONS WITH SEVERE PERSISTENT BIOLOGI CALLY BASED MENTAL ILLNESS.-. No insurer, including health maintenance organizations, nonprofit health care plans and fraternal benefit societies, shall on the basis of a person's severe persistent biologically based mental illness refuse to insure, refuse to continue to insure, limit
the amount, extent or kind of coverage available to a person or treat any person with a severe persistent biologically based mental illness differently than a person with any other illness with respect to the terms, conditions, rates, benefits or requirements of an insurance contract. For purposes of this section, "severe persistent biologically based mental illness" means schizophrenia, bipolar disorder, pervasive developmental disorder or autism, paranoia, panic disorder, obsessive. compulsive disorder or any major depressive disorder."
