19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding twenty-seven thousand
21	five hundred dollars (\$27,500) when the state highway and
22	transportation department certifies the need for the issuance of
23	the bonds. The state board of finance shall schedule the
24	issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and

1 project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable 2 The state board of finance shall further take the 3 time. appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue 4 5 Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the 6 bonds are appropriated to the state highway and transportation department to complete a street improvement project in Thoreau 7 located in McKinley county. Any unexpended or unencumbered 8 9 balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to 10 the severance tax bonding fund. If the state highway and transportation department has not certified the need for the 11 12 issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the 13 authorization provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
