MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE EXPANSION OF ADULT BASIC EDUCATION PROGRAMS AND SERVICES IN RURAL AREAS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 to provide or contract for expansion of the adult basic education programs and services in rural areas of the state, including one full-time employee to administer the adult basic education programs. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
