AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO REPLACE INTERSECTION LIGHTING  
FIXTURES IN MCKINLEY COUNTY; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$175,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state highway and transportation department for expenditure in fiscal years 1997 and 1998 for the purpose of replacing existing lighting fixtures in the vicinity of state highway 264 and U.S. 666 in McKinley county at the Yah-ta-hey junction. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
