18	"74-6-3. WATER QUALITY CONTROL COMMISSION CREATED			
19	A. There is created the "water quality control			
20	commission" consisting of:			
21	(1) the secretary of environment or a member of			
22	his staff designated by him;			
23	(2) the director of the department of game and			
24	fish or a member of his staff designated by him;			
25	(3) the state engineer or a member of his staff

designated by him;

- (4) the chairman of the oil conservation commission or a member of his staff designated by him;
- (5) the director of the state park and recreation division of the energy, minerals and natural resources department or a member of his staff designated by him;
- (6) the director of the New Mexico department of agriculture or a member of his staff designated by him;
- (7) the chairman of the soil and water conservation commission or a [member of his staff] person designated by him;
- (8) the director of the bureau of mines and mineral resources at the New Mexico institute of mining and technology or a member of his staff designated by him; and
- (9) three representatives of the public to be appointed by the governor for [a term] terms of four years and who shall be compensated from the budgeted funds of the department of environment in accordance with the provisions of the Per Diem and Mileage Act.
- B. No member of the commission shall receive or shall have received, during the previous two years, a significant portion of his income directly or indirectly from permit holders or applicants for a permit and shall, upon the acceptance of his appointment and prior to the performance of any of his duties, file a statement of disclosure with the

secretary of state disclosing any amount of money or other valuable consideration, and its source, the value of which is in excess of ten percent of his gross personal income in each of the preceding two years, that he received directly or indirectly from permit holders or applicants for permits required under the Water Quality Act.

- The commission shall elect a chairman and other C. necessary officers and shall keep a record of its proceedings.
- A majority of the commission constitutes a quorum D. for the transaction of business, but no action of the commission is valid unless concurred in by six or more members present at a meeting.
- Ε. The commission is the state water pollution control agency for this state for all purposes of the federal act and the wellhead protection and sole source aquifer programs of the federal Safe Drinking Water Act and may take all action necessary and appropriate to secure to this state, its political subdivisions or interstate agencies the benefits of that act and those programs.
- F. The commission is administratively attached, as defined in the Executive Reorganization Act, to the department of environment."
