19	A. "authority" means the New Mexico finance
20	authority;
21	B. "bond" means any bonds, notes, certificates of
22	participation or other evidence of indebtedness;
23	C. "bondholder" or "holder" means a person who is
24	the owner of a bond, whether registered or not;
25	D. "public project" means the acquisition,
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construction, improvement, alteration or reconstruction of assets of a long-term capital nature by a qualified entity, including [but not limited to] land; buildings; water rights; water, sewerage and waste disposal systems; streets; airports; municipal utilities; parking facilities; and machinery, furniture and equipment. "Public project" includes all proposed expenditures related to the entire undertaking;

"qualified entity" means the state or any agency 8 Ε. 9 or institution of the state or any county, municipality, school 10 district, special district or community water association, a 11 post-secondary school operating pursuant to a charter or 12 authorization from the federal government or an Indian nation, 13 tribe or pueblo located wholly or partially in New Mexico, 14 including a political subdivision or a wholly owned enterprise 15 of an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo; and

F. "security" or "securities", unless the context indicates otherwise, means bonds, notes or other evidence of indebtedness issued by a qualified entity or leases or certificates or other evidence of participation in the lessor's interest in and rights under a lease with a qualified entity and that are payable from taxes, revenues, rates, charges, assessments or user fees or from the proceeds of funding or refunding bonds, notes or other evidences of indebtedness of a qualified entity or from certificates or evidence of participation in a lease with a qualified entity."

23	A. There is created a public body politic and
23 24	corporate constituting a governmental instrumentality to be known
	as the "New Mexico finance authority" for the performance of
25	essential public functions.
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The authority shall be composed of [twelve] B. 2 thirteen members. The state treasurer, the state investment 3 officer, the secretary of finance and administration, the 4 secretary of economic development, the secretary of energy, 5 minerals and natural resources, the secretary of environment, the 6 executive director of the New Mexico municipal league and the 7 executive director of the New Mexico association of counties or 8 their designees shall be ex-officio members of the authority with voting privileges. The governor, with the advice and consent of 9 the senate, shall appoint to the authority the chief financial 10 officer of a state higher educational institution and four members 11 who are residents of the state. The appointed members shall serve 12 at the pleasure of the governor. 13

14 C. The appointed members of the authority shall be 15 appointed to four-year terms. The initial members shall be 16 appointed to staggered terms of four years or less, so that the term of at least one member expires on January 1 of each year. Vacancies shall be filled by appointment by the governor for the 18 remainder of the unexpired term. Any member of the authority 19 shall be eligible for reappointment. 20

D. Each appointed member before entering upon his duty shall take an oath of office to administer the duties of his office faithfully and impartially. A record of the oath shall be filed in the office of the secretary of state.

E. The governor shall designate an appointed member of . 114713. 1

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the authority to serve as chairman. The authority shall elect 2 annually one of its members to serve as vice chairman. The 3 authority shall appoint and prescribe the duties of such other 4 officers, who need not be members, as the authority deems 5 necessary or advisable, including an executive director and a 6 secretary, who may be the same person. The authority may delegate 7 to one or more of its members, officers, employees or agents such 8 powers and duties as it may deem proper and consistent with the New Mexico Finance Authority Act. 9

F. The executive director of the authority shall 11 direct the affairs and business of the authority, subject to the 12 policies, control and direction of the authority. The secretary 13 of the authority shall keep a record of the proceedings of the 14 authority and shall be custodian of all books, documents and 15 papers filed with the authority, the minute book or journal of the 16 authority and its official seal. The secretary shall make copies 17 of all minutes and other records and documents of the authority and give certificates under the official seal of the authority to 18 the effect that the copies are true copies, and all persons 19 dealing with the authority may rely upon the certificates. 20

G. Meetings of the authority shall be held at the call of the chairman or whenever three members shall so request in writing. A majority of members then serving constitutes a quorum for the transaction of any business. The affirmative vote of at least a majority of a quorum present shall be necessary for any action to be taken by the authority. An ex-officio member may

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designate in writing another person to attend meetings of the authority and to the same extent and with the same effect act in his stead. No vacancy in the membership of the authority shall impair the right of a quorum to exercise all rights and perform all duties of the authority.

7 Each member of the authority shall give bond as H. 8 provided in the Surety Bond Act. All costs of the surety bonds shall be borne by the authority. 9

Ι. The authority is not created or organized, and its pperations shall not be conducted, for the purpose of making a profit. No part of the revenues or assets of the authority shall 13 benefit or be distributable to its members, officers or other private persons. The members of the authority shall receive no compensation for their services, but shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses at the same rate and on the same basis as provided for public officers in the Per Diem and Mileage Act.

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J. The authority shall not be subject to the supervision or control of any other board, bureau, department or agency of the state except as specifically provided in the New Mexico Finance Authority Act. No use of the terms "state agency" or "instrumentality" in any other law of the state shall be deemed to refer to the authority unless the authority is specifically referred to in the law.
