MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR ADDITIONAL JUVENILE CORRECTIONS
BEDS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Three million nine hundred
thousand dollars (\$3,900,000) is appropriated from the general
fund to the children, youth and families department for
expenditure in fiscal years 1997 and 1998 to acquire, install,
equip and furnish a total of three fifty-bed secure modulars to
house high-risk youthful offenders at the New Mexico boys'
school, the youth diagnostic and development center or any other
appropriate juvenile facility operated by the department. Any
unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of
fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public

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peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.

1. On page 1, line 11, strike "MAKING AN APPROPRIATION" and
insert in lieu thereof "AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF SEVERANCE TAX
BONDS AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS".

2. On page 1, between lines 14 and 15, insert the following
new section:

"Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--PURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED--
APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS.--The state board of finance may issue
and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax
Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding seven million seven hundred
thousand dollars (\$7,700,000) when the property control division

2 of the general services department certifies the need for the
3 issuance of the bonds. The state board of finance shall schedule
4 the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and
5 economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the
6 project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance
7 and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable
8 time. The state board of finance shall further take the
9 appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue
10 Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds
11 are appropriated to the capital program fund to plan, design,
12 construct, equip and furnish a one-hundred bed care,
13 rehabilitation and treatment facility for male adjudicated
14 delinquents committed to the children, youth and families
15 department in the middle Rio Grande corridor. Any unexpended or
16 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000
17 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the property
18 control division has not certified the need for the issuance of
19 the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization
20 provided in this section shall be void."

3. Renumber the succeeding sections accordingly.

4. On page 1, lines 15 and 16, strike "Three million nine
hundred thousand dollars (\$3,900,000)" and insert in lieu thereof
"Four million four hundred thousand dollars (\$4,400,000)".

5. On page 1, line 19, strike "three" and insert in lieu
thereof "two".

- 7. On page 1, line 21, after "school" insert "and the".
