APPROPRIATION..-One hundred sixty-five thousand dollars (\$165,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the community corrections grant fund for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 so that the corrections department may contract with a nonprofit corporation for the operation of community-based programs that provide services to criminal offenders, including criminal offenders who are veterans of military service. The community-based programs shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Adult Community Corrections Act. Any
