AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR SUPPORT OF VARIOUS PROGRAMS IN CURRY COUNTY; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION-- AGENCIES-- PURPOSES. --

A. Six hundred eighteen thousand eight hundred dollars (\$618,800) is appropriated from the general fund to the following departments for expenditure in fiscal years 1997 and 1998 in the following amounts for the following purposes:

(1) one hundred seventy thousand dollars (\$170,000) to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for support of the Curry county driving while intoxicated program, including the teen court and teens need teens programs, prevention education in the schools, screening and assessment of offenders and both a program

1 probation officer and a program coordinator;

2 (2) fifty-six thousand two hundred dollars  
3 (\$56,200) to the local government division of the department of  
4 finance and administration for support of a Curry county special  
5 driving while intoxicated program, including enforcement,  
6 offender database, purchase of breathalyzers and support of the  
7 treatment committee;

8 (3) thirty-nine thousand eight hundred dollars  
9 (\$39,800) to the department of health for support of the Curry  
10 county maternal and child health council;

11 (4) two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to  
12 the state housing authority of the economic development  
13 department for home rehabilitation for low-income persons;

14 (5) ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) to the state  
15 agency on aging for installation of ramps for handicapped and  
16 elderly low-income persons;

17 (6) thirty-two thousand six hundred dollars  
18 (\$32,600) to the state agency on aging for support of the  
19 retired senior volunteer program;

20 (7) seventy thousand nine hundred dollars  
21 (\$70,900) to the state agency on aging for support of the foster  
22 grandparent program;

23 (8) twelve thousand one hundred dollars  
24 (\$12,100) to the state highway and transportation department to  
25 support the youth employment and highway beautification

2 (9) twenty-seven thousand two hundred dollars

5 B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining

7 Section 2. EMERGENCY. --It is necessary for the public  
8 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
