BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRI ATI ON- - AGENCI ES- - PURPOSES. - -

Six hundred eighteen thousand eight hundred A. dollars (\$618,800) is appropriated from the general fund to the following departments for expenditure in fiscal years 1997 and 1998 in the following amounts for the following purposes:

(1) one hundred seventy thousand dollars (\$170,000) to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for support of the Curry county driving while intoxicated program, including the teen court and teens need teens programs, prevention education in the schools, screening and assessment of offenders and both a program

probation officer and a program coordinator;
