1 possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the 2 project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. 3 The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps 4 necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as 5 6 amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are 7 appropriated to the local government division for the purpose of remodeling and constructing an addition to the Portales public 8 9 library located in Roosevelt county. Any unexpended or 10 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 11 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the local 12 government division has not certified the need for the issuance 13 of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization 14 provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
