18	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
19	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
20	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
21	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding sixty thousand
22	dollars (\$60,000) when the state highway and transportation
23	department certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds.
24	The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale
25	of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner

1 possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the 2 project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. 3 The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps 4 necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as 5 6 amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the state highway and transportation department 7 for the purpose of completing an archaeological survey and data 8 9 recovery on McKinley county road 19 near Borrego pass located in 10 McKinley county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance 11 remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the 12 severance tax bonding fund. If the state highway and 13 transportation department has not certified the need for the 14 issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the 15 authorization provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
