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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS The state board of finance may issue
19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one million five
21	hundred thousand dollars ($\$1, 500, 000$) when the office of
22	cultural affairs certifies the need for the issuance of the
23	bonds. The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance
24	and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical
25	manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project has

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been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are amended. appropriated to the office of cultural affairs for the purpose of constructing phase one of a facility consisting of a visitors' center, staff housing and a maintenance shop; for 8 equipping, landscaping and site development; and to pay all related professional and administrative fees to complete construction of the Bosque Redondo memorial and museum located 12 in De Baca county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance 13 remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the 14 severance tax bonding fund. If the office of cultural affairs has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.

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
