Designate the product 8 "A": 9 (5) add "A" to the mileage supplement. 10 The sum of "A" and the mileage supplement is "B"; 11 12 (6) for the 1995-96 and the 1996-97 school years, "B" shall not be less than ninety-five percent or more 13 14 than one hundred fifteen percent of the district's previous year's operational allocation, provided that if "B" is less than 15 16 ninety-five percent, "B" is deemed to equal ninety-five percent 17 and if "B" is greater than one hundred fifteen percent, "B" is 18 deemed equal to one hundred fifteen percent. years, the transportation allocation for each school district shall not be less than ninety-five percent or more than one hundred fifteen percent of the 1996-97 school year's transportation allocation.

C. For districts transporting [<del>less</del>] <u>fewer</u> than seventy-five students, the department [<del>of education</del>] may [<u>utilize</u>] <u>use</u> alternative calculation methods to determine the transportation allocation pursuant to regulation of the state board."

Section 2. Section 22-8-29.2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1995, Chapter 208, Section 11) is amended to read:

"22-8-29.2. GROUPING OF DISTRICTS--CALCULATION OF [AVERAGE SQUARE] <u>NUMBER OF</u> MILES [SERVED] <u>TRAVELED</u> PER STUDENT TRANSPORTED.--

A. The department [of education] shall group school districts into not more than twelve groups. Groupings shall be made on the basis of the [average square] <u>number of miles</u> [served] traveled per student transported in the district in the [prior] current year on the fortieth day of school; provided, districts transporting [less] fewer than seventy-five students may be excluded from the groupings regardless of the [average square] miles per student transported.

B. The [average square] <u>number of miles [served]</u> <u>traveled</u> per student transported shall be calculated by dividing the total [square] mileage [served] <u>traveled</u> by the district by
