AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES: AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF SEVERANCE TAX BONDS FOR INFRASTRUCTURE RENOVATION AND EXPANSION OF AGING CENTRALIZED SYSTEMS ON THE CAMPUSES OF STATE COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES: MAKING APPROPRIATIONS: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--AUTHORIZATIONS--Section 1. APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS. --

The state board of finance may issue and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding Act in an amount not to exceed the total of the amounts authorized for purposes specified in Sections 2 through 10 of The state board of finance shall schedule the this act. issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the

project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. Proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated for the purposes specified in Sections 2 through 10 of this act.

- B. The agencies named in Sections 2 through 10 of this act shall certify to the state board of finance when the money from the proceeds of the severance tax bonds authorized in this section is needed for the purposes specified in the applicable section of this act.
- C. If the specified agency has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this act shall be void.
- D. Unless otherwise specified in this act, any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining from the proceeds of severance tax bonds issued pursuant to Sections 2 through 10 of this act at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund.

Section 2. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the board of regents of the university of New Mexico that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, two million nine hundred thousand

dollars (\$2,900,000) is appropriated to the board of regents of the university of New Mexico for the purpose of funding infrastructure renovation and expansion of aging centralized systems on the campus of the university of New Mexico located in Bernalillo county.

Section 3. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--BOARD OF REGENTS OF EASTERN NEW MEXICO UNIVERSITY--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the board of regents of eastern New Mexico university that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, one million two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$1,250,000) is appropriated to the board of regents of eastern New Mexico university for the purpose of funding infrastructure renovation and expansion of aging centralized systems on the eastern New Mexico university campus located in Roosevelt county.

Section 4. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--BOARD OF REGENTS OF NEW MEXICO HIGHLANDS UNIVERSITY--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the board of regents of New Mexico highlands university that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) is appropriated to the board of regents of New Mexico highlands university for the purpose of funding infrastructure renovation and expansion of aging centralized systems on the campus of New Mexico highlands university located in San Miguel county.

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Section 5. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE NEW MEXICO INSTITUTE OF MINING AND TECHNOLOGY--PURPOSE. --Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the board of regents of the New Mexico institute of mining and technology that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, eight hundred thousand dollars (\$800,000) is appropriated to the board of regents of the New Mexico institute of mining and technology for the purpose of funding infrastructure renovation and expansion of aging centralized systems on the campus of the New Mexico institute of mining and technology located in Socorro county.

SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--BOARD OF REGENTS OF NEW Section 6. MEXICO STATE UNIVERSITY--PURPOSES.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the board of regents of New Mexico state university that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated to the board of regents of New Mexico state university for the following purposes:

- two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for the purpose of funding infrastructure renovation and expansion of aging centralized systems on the main campus of New Mexico state university located in Dona Ana county;
- one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the B. purpose of funding infrastructure renovation and expansion of aging centralized systems on the Alamogordo campus of New Mexico

state university located in Otero county; and

C. two hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$225,000) for the purpose of funding infrastructure renovation and expansion of aging centralized systems on the Dona Ana campus of New Mexico state university located in Dona Ana county.

Section 7. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--BOARD OF REGENTS OF WESTERN NEW MEXICO UNIVERSITY--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the board of regents of western New Mexico university that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, eight hundred thousand dollars (\$800,000) is appropriated to the board of regents of western New Mexico university for the purpose of funding infrastructure renovation and expansion of aging centralized systems on the western New Mexico university campus located in Grant county.

Section 8. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE NORTHERN NEW MEXICO STATE SCHOOL--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the board of regents of the northern New Mexico state school that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, five hundred ninety-seven thousand dollars (\$597,000) is appropriated to the board of regents of the northern New Mexico state school for the purpose of funding infrastructure renovation and expansion of aging centralized systems on the northern New Mexico state

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school campus located in Rio Arriba county.

Section 9. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--GOVERNING BOARD OF CLOVIS COMMUNITY COLLEGE--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the governing board of Clovis community college that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, three hundred ninety-two thousand five hundred dollars (\$392,500) is appropriated to the governing board of Clovis community college for the purpose of funding infrastructure renovation and expansion of aging centralized systems on the Clovis community college campus located in Curry county.

Section 10. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--GOVERNING BOARD OF NEW MEXICO JUNIOR COLLEGE--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the governing board of New Mexico junior college that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) is appropriated to the governing board of New Mexico junior college for the purpose of funding infrastructure renovation and expansion of aging centralized systems on the campus of New Mexico junior college located in Lea county.

Section 11. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
