16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one million nine
21	hundred eighty thousand dollars (\$1,980,000) when the local
22	government division of the department of finance and
23	administration certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds.
24	The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale
25	of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner

1 possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the 2 project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. 3 The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps 4 necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as 5 6 amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are 7 appropriated to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for the purpose of demolishing and 8 9 removing unsuitable buildings and planning, designing and 10 constructing a new multipurpose exhibition and activities 11 facility at the southern New Mexico state fairgrounds located in 12 Dona Ana county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance 13 remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the 14 severance tax bonding fund. If the local government division of 15 the department of finance and administration has not certified 16 the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 17 1999, the authorization provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
