AN ACT

RELATING TO COUNTIES; INCREASING THE MEMBERS OF COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSIONS IN CERTAIN CLASS A COUNTIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 4-57-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1967, Chapter 150, Section 1) is amended to read:

"4-57-1. CREATION OF PLANNING COMMISSION. --

A. Any county may by ordinance establish a planning commission. Except as provided in Subsection B of this section, a county planning commission shall consist of not less than five ~~[(5)]~~ members who shall be appointed by the board of county [commission] commissioners. Administrative officials of the county may be appointed as ex-officio nonvoting members of the planning commission.
