18	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
19	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
20	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
21	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one hundred twenty-
22	five thousand dollars (\$125,000) when the office of cultural
23	affairs certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. The

1 upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can 2 proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board 3 of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to 4 comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. 5 The 6 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the office of cultural affairs for the purpose of installing a 7 heating and ventilation air conditioning control system in the 8 9 international space hall of fame and Clyde W. Tombaugh space 10 theater located in Otero county. Any unexpended or unencumbered 11 balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to 12 If the office of cultural the severance tax bonding fund. 13 affairs has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in 14 15 this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
