19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding two hundred fifty
21	thousand dollars (\$250,000) when the department of environment
22	certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. The state
23	board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the
24	bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible
25	upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed

1 sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board 2 of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to 3 comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The 4 5 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the 6 department of environment for the purpose of improving the water and sewer system in the village of Cloudcroft located in Otero 7 Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the 8 county. 9 end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax 10 bonding fund. If the department of environment has not 11 certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of 12 fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this section 13 shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
