16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding six hundred eight
21	thousand five hundred twenty dollars ($\$608, 520$) when the state
22	department of public education certifies the need for the
23	issuance of the bonds. The state board of finance shall
24	schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most
25	expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the

board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the state department of public education for the purpose of purchasing and installing new playground equipment and purchasing, installing and making repairs to the Hodgin elementary school's heating, cooling and ventilation systems Any unexpended or located in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county. unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the state department of public education has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
