17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
18	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
19	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
20	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
21	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding ninety-eight thousand
22	dollars (\$98,000) when the state department of public education
23	certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. The state
24	board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the
25	bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible

1 upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can 2 proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board 3 of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to 4 comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. 5 The 6 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the state department of public education for the purpose of 7 improving its computer skills education capabilities by 8 9 purchasing and installing computer, electrical and 10 telecommunications equipment and supplies and renovating portions of Bel Air elementary school in Albuquerque located in 11 12 Bernalillo county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance 13 remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the 14 severance tax bonding fund. If the state department of public 15 education has not certified the need for the issuance of the 16 bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided 17 in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
